Student Accomplishments!

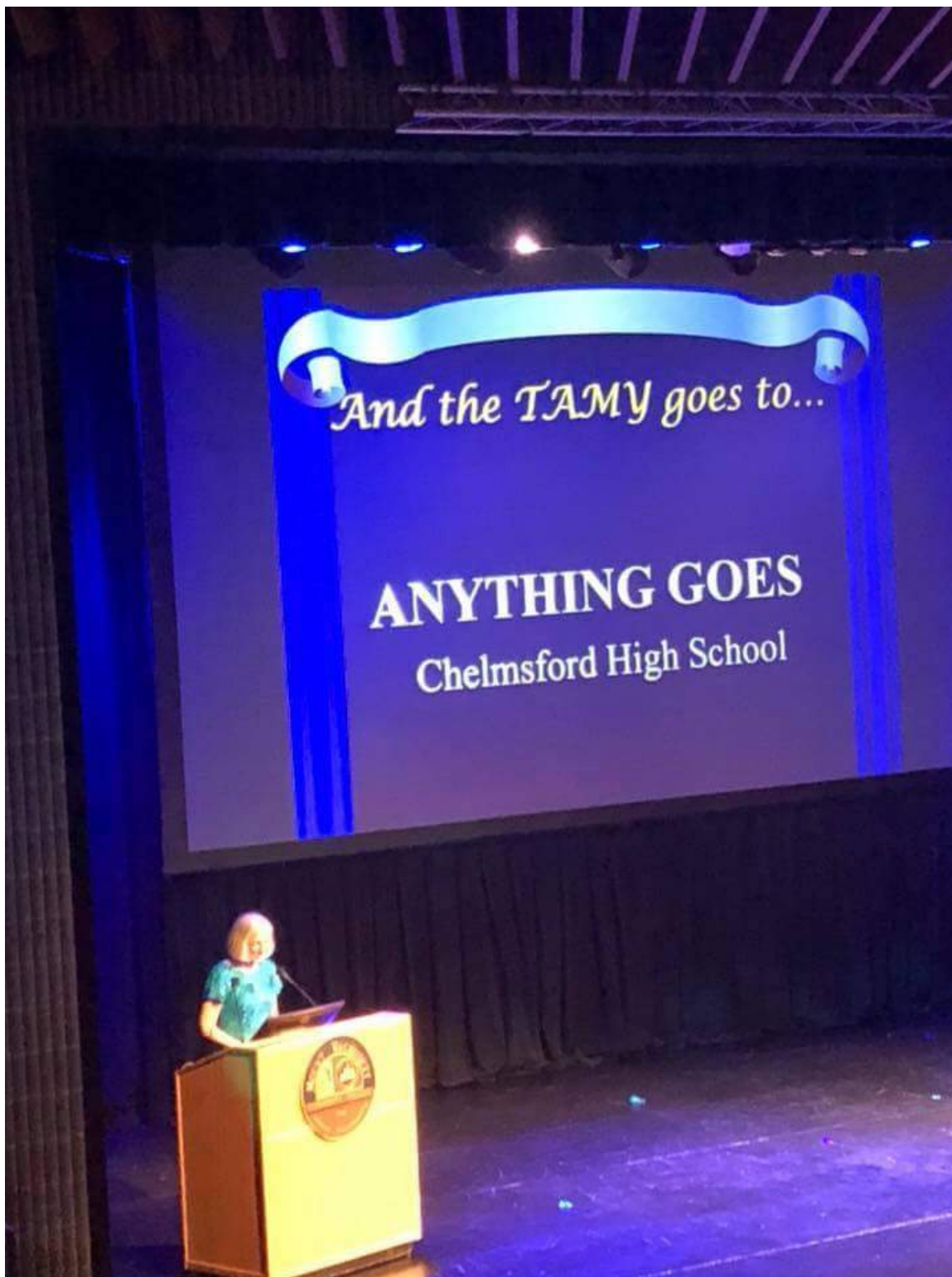
